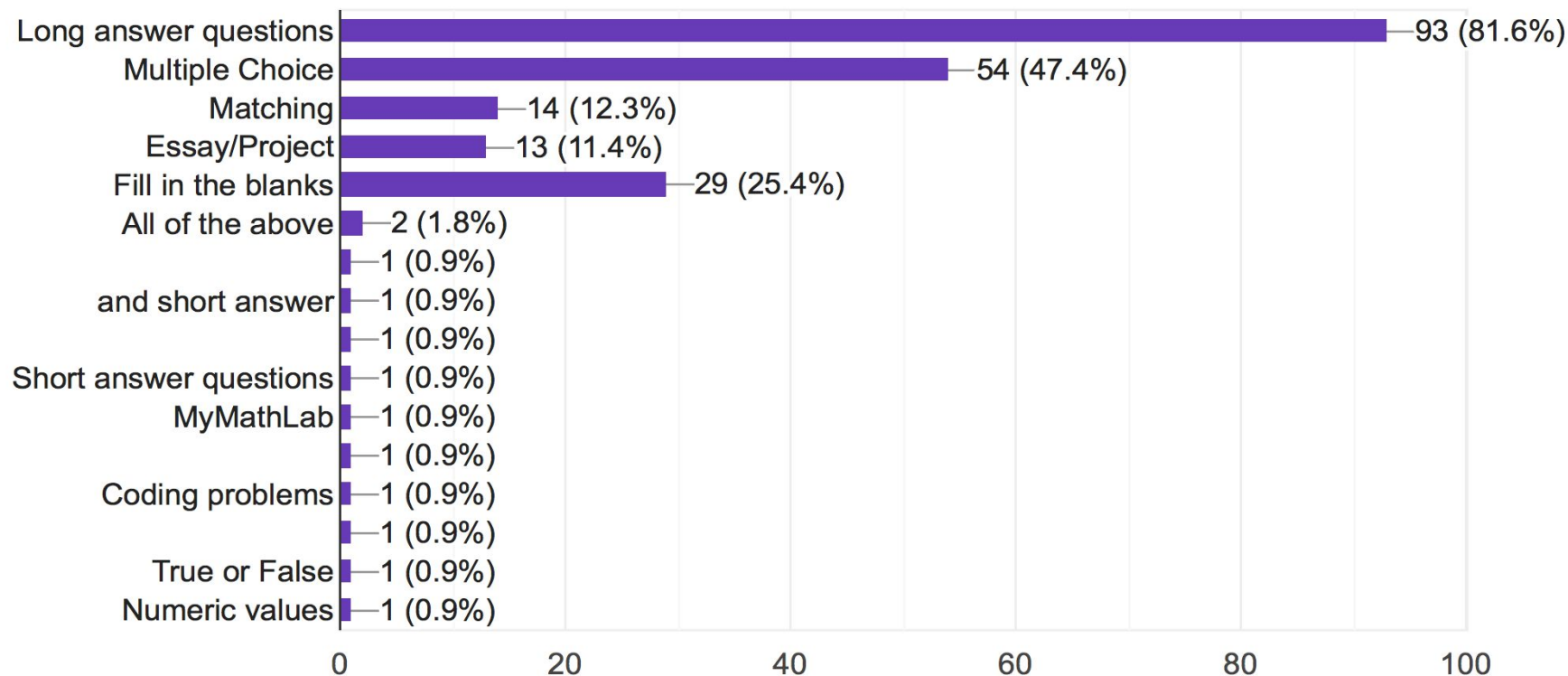

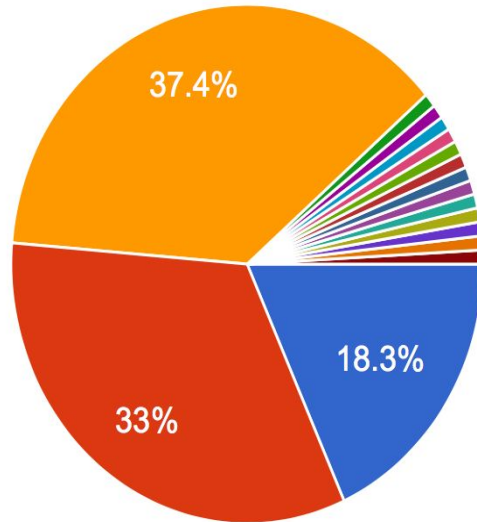

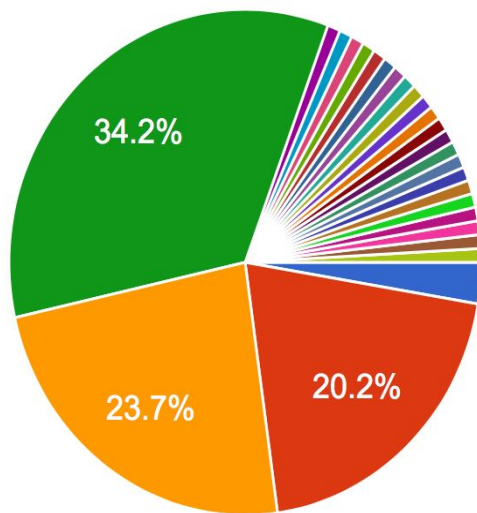

Delivery of assessment ...

- Multiple versions of an assessment, i.e., excessively randomizing questions
- Oral interview
- Open ended questions
- Personalized questions
- Less calculation type questions
- Multiple choice questions
- Working through online modules and writing reflective essay-type questions
- Open book assessment
- Collaboration with peers

Controlling the assessment ...

- Timed environment
